

WHEN AND WHERE CAN YOU DONATE?

We appreciate your generosity and continued support. Your donations greatly help the AWL shelter and the animals awaiting their forever homes.

Donations of clean, usable items can be brought to The Menagerie Tuesday through Saturday, between 10 AM and 5:30 PM. Items are accepted at the intake door at the rear of the store (on the Dairy Queen side of the building).

Due to the small size of our intake area & to comply with fire codes, we ask that you call to schedule any donation if it is larger than three large garbage bags or three medium boxes. Large unscheduled donations may be turned away

due to lack of space and priority will be given to scheduled donations; however, we will try our best to accommodate everyone.

If you would like a tax receipt for your donation, we will gladly provide you with one.

Due to fire codes, zoning ordinances, safety, and exposure to weather, donations cannot be left outside when the store is not open. Donations cannot block the emergency exit doors, garage doors, or resident areas, nor can they be left in the driveway, parking lot, or at the front entrance.

If no one is available to answer the intake door or if we are full and not taking donations, please call to schedule your donation and return at another time.
