AWL BENEFITS FROM BETTY WHITE'S LEGACY

The world lost a great animal advocate when Betty White passed on December 31, 2021. The 99-year-old actress and comedian was a pioneer in early television with a career spanning seven decades. It goes without saying that White left a legacy in the entertainment industry. First, by being the first woman to work both in front of and behind the camera. Second, for her most famous roles on The Carol Burnett Show, The Mary Tyler Moore Show, The Golden Girls and Hot in Cleveland, just to name a few!

Following the news of Betty White's passing a social media challenge flooded platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, and Reddit. White was a pet enthusiast and animal welfare advocate since the early 1970's. White worked with organizations such as the Los Angeles Zoo Commission, The Morris Animal Foundation, African Wildlife Foundation, and many others. The challenge asked participants to give \$5.00 or more to an animal welfare organization in the actress' memory.

On top of the Betty White Challenge on social media, AWL and BGMG Marketing & Fundraising teamed up to host Bingo with Betty. A one night event at the shelter, held on what would have been Betty White's 100th birthday, where people could gather for coffee and cheesecake (the favorite late night snack of The Golden Girls), bingo, episodes of The Golden Girls, and hot dogs and chips (White's favorite meal). Despite having to postpone the event a few days due to a snow storm, it was a huge success raising over \$5,000 for AWL. Additionally, individual donations made in Betty White's memory as a part of the challenge brought in almost \$8,000 for AWL.

Betty White is quoted as saying "animals are near and dear to my heart, and I've devoted my life to trying to improve their lives." It would seem that even in her death White is improving the lives of animals around this country!

Thank you, Betty White, for the legacy of caring for animals you left, and thank you to everyone who participated in the Betty White Challenge and Bingo with Betty.

HUMANE DEPARTMENT

UPDATE

Recently, AWL has seen an increase in the amount of cat hoarding cases in our humane department. In March of 2021, we had a call about an unpleasant odor coming from inside a home. Officers responded and stepped into the home to discover nearly 70 cats inside. The conditions inside the home were beyond what one could imagine. The smell of ammonia required officers to wear respirators. The occupants were unable to provide the minimal standards of nutrition, cleanliness, and veterinary care. This magnitude of neglect in hoarding cases often results in starvation, illness and death of the animals.

Most all of the cats had been born inside the residence and were not socialized, ill, infested with fleas and unable to be touched. The interior of the home was polluted with urine and feces making it unlivable for humans and animals. The stairs were collapsing from the urine and feces and the ceiling had caved in exposing the rafters. Officers began the process of removing all of the cats from the home. Many of the cats were in the rafters hiding and had to be trapped to be removed. Officers found 3 deceased cats in the couch cushions.

Some animal hoarders begin collecting after a traumatic event or loss, while others see themselves as “rescuers” who save animals from lives on the street. We have also seen situations where good intentions go bad when someone takes in a cat or two and is unable to financially afford to spay and neuter them. Quickly they have eight cats in the home, when they were unable to provide food and medical care for just those first two. Recognizing this need in the community the AWL has implemented a low cost spay and neuter program, a pet food pantry and a medical assistance program that have all been made possible by the legacy of Glen



and Jean Harnett. Our goal is to help our community by connecting pet owners with available resources.

Sadly, not all of the cats in this situation could be saved. Their owners have been placed on probation and have been court ordered to have a mental health assessment to ensure they too receive the care they need. Through the efforts of the humane officers and prosecutors they are no longer allowed to own animals so they do not end up in the same situation again.

Meet Brooks!

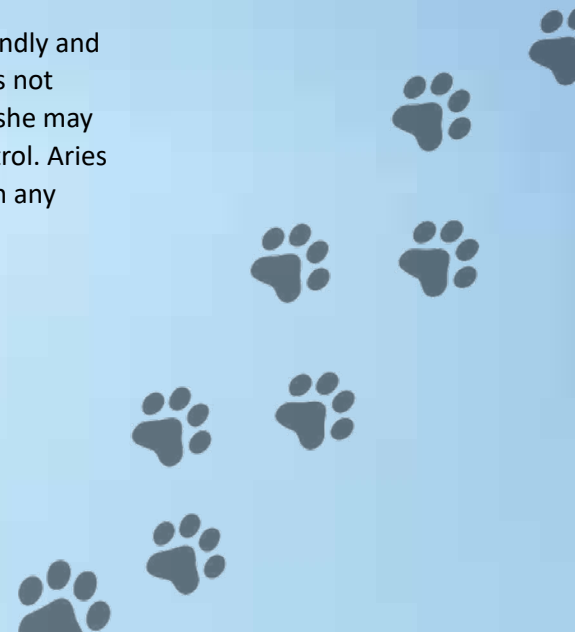

Healing for Pretty Girl



Parrots are some of the most unique and intelligent animals we care for here at the shelter. Often these feathered companions develop complex attachments to their caretakers and environment, which may pose special challenges to shelter staff.

In September of 2020 the Animal Welfare League received a little cockatiel named Pretty Girl. Pretty Girl was grieving the loss of her human companion and her lifelong home. Her human caretaker had passed away leaving her to family members who felt they were out of their depth with the distraught little bird. On her way from her lifelong home to the shelter, she panicked and damaged her wing.

Pretty Girl's extended family believed she was over 20 years old when her owner passed. During her time at the shelter animal care staff tried their best to make Pretty Girl feel at home. Despite the best efforts of shelter staff, Pretty Girl would still panic and hurt her wing over and over again. She was given toys, a quiet place to live, and even watched Bird TV on YouTube during the day. None of these accommodations, however, would heal Pretty Girl's heart like finding a new home would.

When Rebecca heard about Pretty Girl, she knew she could provide a good home for the troubled bird. Rebecca had a cockatiel of her own, Bindi, and was well versed in bird behavior and wellness. Pretty Girl made her way to her new home in December 2020. She slowly came around to be friends with Bindi and her wing began to heal as she settled into her new environment. Gaining the trust of a bird is no easy task so Rebecca has rejoiced with each little victory. "I know it doesn't seem like much, but she took some morsels of bread that I set on the edge of her dish for the first time the other day. I was thrilled!"

We are so happy and relieved that Pretty Girl and Rebecca found each other. It can be a tedious process and some days are better than others, but Rebecca remains persistent and loving. Pretty Girl's story is a reminder that it is important to take time to find the right home for each animal. Every animal that comes into our care is a unique individual deserving of the type of respect and understanding that Rebecca has shown to Pretty Girl.

THE MENAGERIE BY AWL GETS A MAKEOVER!

In December of 1995 AWL opened the doors to The Menagerie Thrift & Gift Shoppe. The intention being to take gently used clothing, home goods, and other items and turn them into operating income for the shelter. Since that time the community has helped to grow the store into the largest single fundraiser supporting the daily operations of AWL.

Over the last three years, AWL decided to re-brand the store and give it some much needed TLC. The current location of The Menagerie on East Market Street in Howland needed more than a little work. Foundation repairs were needed, a flood in early 2020 created the need for major work to the two back rooms of the building, and the sales floor needed updating. Finally, in July 2021 the project was complete!

New signs on the building and street show the new Menagerie; The Menagerie by AWL allows the public to more closely relate the animal shelter side of AWL with The Menagerie side of AWL. New paint and colors, matching those at the shelter, on

the sales floor area ties the two locations together. Photos of animals available for adoption stream on a TV behind the cash register. Possibly the most important improvement is that the building is safe and secure after significant work to the foundation.

The amazing staff and volunteers who operate The Menagerie by AWL are rejuvenated with the improvements. In the last 11 months the store has seen the highest sales in the store's history. New customers are shopping with us on a daily basis. All translating into more funding to support the abused, neglected, and unwanted animals around Trumbull County.
